Throughout the evening there are prizes to be won and fun is had by all. All proceeds go to the PTA who are saving for new projects (any ideas please contact PTA).

THINGS TO BUY

Drinks, crisps and sweets are on sale priced from 10p - 30p (there will be free healthy snacks available).
The children will be able to buy glow sticks (while stocks last) for £1 and face art from 50p - £1.

WATER BOTTLES

This year in order to reduce waste we ask that all children bring a named water bottle which we can refill on the night.

MONEY

Money should be in a named purse (small change would be appreciated).

DROPPING OFF YOUR CHILD (PLEASE WEAR A FACE MASK)

We encourage parents to walk to and from the disco with their children so as to reduce traffic in the area.
Access to the site is via the gate at the corner of the field or via the Foundation gate. The entrance for the disco is at the Foundation class tunnel (opposite Middle School), when the doors open we will register the children and collect their entrance fee. All Middle and Upper School children arriving before the start of their disco will be registered and taken to a supervised waiting area before the doors open.

COLLECTING YOUR CHILD (PLEASE WEAR A FACE MASK)

When each disco finishes the DJ will get the children seated on the floor. Parents please come into the hall from the door near the swimming pool / PTA garage, collect your child and leave with them. **No children will be allowed out on their own.**

HELPERS

FAMILY LOUNGE

Due to popular demand we will once again be offering a family lounge located in middle school for parents and siblings who wish to remain on site. 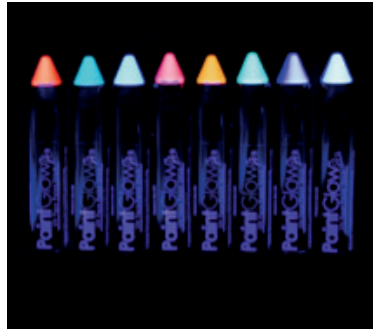
As you may have seen we are starting to reduce the plastic usage at the school discos

- Firstly, we are asking children to bring a drink in their named daily water bottles. We can refill water for free and 5p for squash on the night.
- Secondly we are offering UV face paint for face and hands (this is instead of us buying lots more glow stick accessories which is one use plastic).
- As this is a Neon themed disco - If your child wears light / white clothing for the neon lights they should get the WOW factor.

If your child is allergic to any of the ingredients below, please advise them not to come for a UV paint effect. The paints are of Premium Quality - Made in the UK & Cosmetically Certified.

Ingredients:

Ricinus Communis Seed Oil, Bis(glycidoxyphenyl) propane / Bisaminomethylnorbornane Copolymer, Paraffinum Liquidum, Paraffin, Talc, Cera Alba, Lanolin, Euphorbia Cerifera Cera, Copernicia Cerifera Cera, Cetyl Alcohol, Cera Microcristallina, Polyethylene, Synthetic Wax, Propyl Gallate, Citric Acid, Propylene Glycol, BHA, Aluminum Hydroxide, Fluorescent Brightener



Useful tips if this is your first disco

“I generally give my child a further £2 to spend while at the Disco on some of the following: Glow sticks, Face paint, Candyfloss, Sweets, Chocolate, Crisps.

So, in total I give my child £5 for the whole disco.”

The entrance to the disco is the foundation tunnel, children pay and are registered in. No parents beyond this point please, but please don't worry there will be teachers and parent volunteers to help encourage any nervous first timers!?

If you could take your child's coat home it helps for a speedy pick up when you collect your child from the school hall. The double doors by the garage/scooter area are opened and **your child will only be released when a parent has been seen!**

A couple of parents do ask about dressing up to which I reply, “We do see lots of little girls dressed as princesses, but for the boys it gets a little warm in there for Spider-man and Batman outfits so I would discourage it!”
