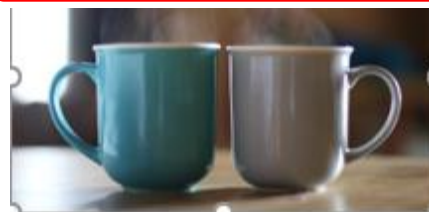

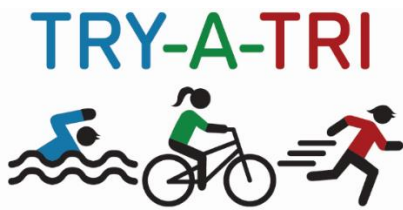
The Family Lounge will be running outside on the school field once again.
