In order to join, once your child has arranged a team of 3, one swimmer, one cyclist and one runner and come up with a team name, please follow the link below to the PTA Try-a-tri application form to enter your child in their race. Each parent or carer should enter their child separately, so there will be 3 applications per team.

Teams will compete against others from the same school group (Lower, Middle and Upper), teams can be made up of participants from within the same school group, they don't have to be in the same class or year. Girls and boys can participate in the same team.
