THINGS TO BUY – Drinks, crisps and sweets are on sale priced from 10p - 50p (£1 for
candyfloss/pringles).

The children will be able to buy simple glow stick's from 20p, to novelty flashing glasses
at £2 and face art
for 50p.

WATER BOTTLES – To reduce waste we ask that all children bring a named water bottle
which we can refill
on the night.

MONEY – Money should be in a named purse (small change would be appreciated).

DROPPING OFF YOUR CHILD – We encourage parents to walk to and from the disco
with their children to

reduce traffic in the area. Access to the site is via the Foundation gate. The entrance for
the disco is at the

Foundation class entrance, when the doors open, we will register the children and
collect their entrance
fee of £3.00 per child.

COLLECTING YOUR CHILD – When each disco finishes the DJ will get the children
seated on the floor.

Parent's, please come in from the hall door near the swimming pool / PTA garage,
collect your child and

leave with them. No children will be allowed out on their own, this includes the Year 5/6
children.

HELPERS – We need helpers on the evening in the parent bar and in the disco to
supervise the children. If

USEFUL TIPS:

- “I generally give my child a further £3 - £4 to spend while at the Disco on some of the
following:

Novelty Glasses, Glow sticks, Face paint, Candyfloss, Sweets, Chocolate, Crisps. So, in
total I give my
child £5 to £7 for the whole disco.”

- The entrance to the disco is the foundation tunnel, children pay and are registered in.

beyond this point please, but please don't worry there will be teachers and parent volunteers to

help encourage any nervous first timers!?

- If you could take your child's coat home, it helps for a speedy pick up when you collect your child

from the school hall. The double doors by the garage/scooter area are opened and your child will

only be released when a parent has been seen!

- A couple of parents do ask about dressing up to which I reply, "We do see lots of little girls dressed

as princesses, but for the boys it gets a little warm in there for Spider-Man and Batman outfits so I

would discourage it!"

- Ear defenders are very welcome, though quieter than at adult event, it can still feel very loud if this

is your child's first disco, we do have children in MS/US that come wearing them until they feel

settled.
