



Create-a-Card - Lead still needed!

Thank you to the families who have volunteered to organise the Diwali Fayre on 17th October. The Diwali Fayre is a highlight of the Autumn Term with amazing food, cultural performances, and entertainment for all regardless of faith.

Autumn Disco and Family Lounge: Thursday 23rd October – Co-lead still needed!

All Aldryngton children are welcome to attend the disco for their age group. A professional DJ provides the music and the children are supervised by parents and teachers. Throughout the evening there are prizes to be won and fun is had by all.

The Family Lounge is in Middle School for parents and siblings who wish to remain on site during the disco. The family lounge will be serving a variety of alcohol and non-alcoholic drinks and snacks.

Disco Co-Lead (MS/US) - Still needed!

The PTA organise a school disco three times per year, once per term, usually just before the half-term holiday. The current event lead is a Lower School parent who needs some help, particularly with Middle & Upper School. The co-lead will need to support liaising with school and DJ, purchasing supplies and then setting up and running the disco.
