## Get involved with your PTA

The PTA plays a vital role in supporting Aldryngton School by raising additional funds and running events that add so much to our children's school experience. There are lots of ways to get involved, whether you have a little time or a lot — every contribution makes a difference.

### How to get involved

1. Get involved with **organizing an event** — join the leadership team.
  - We are still looking for a Middle and Upper School Disco Lead, and we always welcome more people to help with organizing events to create a Leading Team rather than single person.
2. Attend **PTA meetings** — they occur once per term, dates are on the PTA website, and in the latest minutes. Next PTA meeting is scheduled for **5th March 2026**
3. Volunteer for events with **setting up, during and tidying after**, and organize **match funding** to boost your contribution

### This is a critical moment for our events.

We are currently short on volunteers for all events, and without additional help, we will not be able to continue running all our upcoming events. If enough people step forward, we can keep these events going — but without that support some will have to stop. If you value these events, please

consider volunteering when requests are sent out. Your involvement directly determines what we can continue to offer.

## Match Funding

### What is Match Funding?

If you take part in a fundraising event, then your employer will match the funds raised at the event. Sometimes it could be a proportion of the amount and sometimes the amount in full. In the past, this has raised thousands of pounds for the PTA. We would be grateful if you let the PTA know if your employer supports this scheme. HR departments can usually advise you on this.

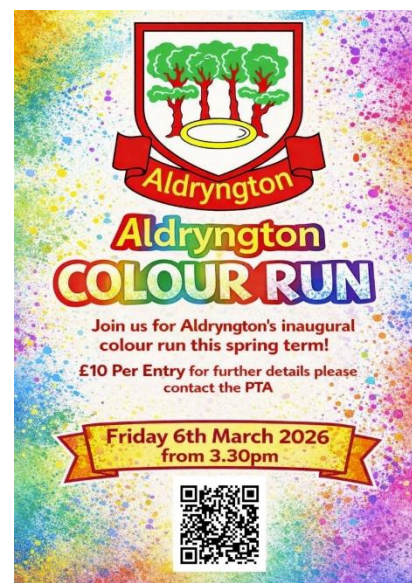

## Spring Term Events

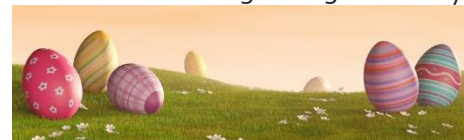
**Disco and Family Lounge** — Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> February

Members collaborate to oversee the opening of the heated outdoor pool, ensuring a summer of fun and relaxation for all. ### Try-a-Tri, Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2026

Try-a-Tri is a fun and inclusive sporting event, which has been run during the summer term since 2011. The event is open to all Aldryngton pupils from Foundation to Year 6. It is a Triathlon, a 3-in-1 race made up of swimming, cycling, and running. For the event children form teams of three (a swimmer, a cyclist, and a runner) to compete against other teams.

This is a huge fundraiser for the PTA, and a truly popular event with Aldryngton families. It requires a huge number of volunteers on the day, watch out for requests to volunteer.
